## Main Taproom

Here you'll find the ales and lagers from the main system, cleanly fermented in stainless steel vessels. These are the beers you'll find out in the market and include IPA's, Stouts, Pilsners, and many other top and bottom fermented beers, including our core CMYK and PMS beers.

## The Bindery

The Bindery is home to our Farmhouse program, where we seek to create beers that represent the Belgian and French countryside breweries we love for their esoteric and special styles of ale. Here, old world brewing methods and time honored traditional lagering and aging techniques combine to create unique and distinctive ales and lagers. All these beers have aged a minimum of 6 months in barrels in our wild room. Some ales need more time - our Méthode Traditionnelle beers have aged 2-3 years in wine barrels. For many of these beers, we carefully choose and blend young and more mature barrels until the perfect depth of flavor is achieved. In the Bindery, beer reconnects with nature's influence. The time and patience required to create these beers is rewarded by the individuality expressed by each.

### Lagerbier

#### **Everyday Yellow – German Pilsner, ABV 5.0% | 14 oz draft \$7 | 7 oz draft \$3.50 | 6 pack cans \$10.99**

Our Everyday Yellow is a simple expression of our admiration for German beer. Classic bready body with malty sweetness with an exquisite balance lent by the floral spiciness from the noble Hersbrucker hops.

#### **Trojan Chronicle – Bohemian (Czech) Pilsner, ABV 5.9% | 14 oz draft \$7 | 7 oz draft \$3.50**

Trojan Chronicle holds a special place in our heart here at Printer's, as the name has a double meaning: first, the Trojans are the mascot of our town's schools and second the name refers to one of the oldest printed books in Czech history, The Trojan Chronicle. In holding with our values of heritage and precision, this beer was brewed with floor malted Bohemian Pils malt and Czech Saaz hops to give it a crisp body and spicy hop note that the style is known for. We hope you can appreciate the history and tradition of the Czech style beer in your hand and feel the love we have for Carrollton in every sip! Na zdraví!

#### **Dylux – Light American Lager, ABV 4.2% | 16 oz draft \$5 | 8 oz draft \$2.50 | 12 pack cans \$15.99 | 24 pack \$26.99**

Think Carling Black Label. This was the beer we modeled when we created Dylux. A beer that tastes like beer, we aimed to create an extremely easy drinking beer that had flavor. We think we hit the mark.

#### **Heritage Series Helles – Helles, ABV 5.9% | 1L draft \$13 | .5L draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50**

Helles and Pilsner are similar in style, both being classic German lagerbiers. Helles came to life in southern Germany as an alternative to the beloved Czech Pilsner, and is the beer of choice in Munich. Where a Czech Pils is crisp and spicy, Helles has a bit more malt heft, chewiness. Pouring a beautiful light straw with a fluffy white head, the mouthfeel is full and substantial. Biscuit and warm crusty bread, balanced by earth, spicy hops. Prost!

**Speak The 3<sup>rd</sup> Most Italian – Italian Pilsner, ABV 5.5% | 14 oz draft \$7 | 7 oz draft \$3.50**

Utilizing the same basic build as a German Pilsner, the Italian Pilsner differentiates itself through the gentle addition of very slight dry hopping, imparting a pronounced European hop character. The body is light and clean, balanced. We utilize Hallertau Blanc and Mandarinina Bavaria hops for their lemongrass and citrusy aromas. The result is a wonderfully easy drinking lager that embraces noble hop characteristics but doesn't overwhelm the palette with hop bitterness. Godersi la vita!

**IPA**

**Everyday Cyan – West Coast IPA, ABV 7.0% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50 | 6 pack cans \$10.99**

What can be said about the OG West Coast IPA? Brilliant and beautiful, our Everyday Cyan is a perfect example of the style. Packed with tropical and citrus hop aromas upfront, there is a sturdy malt backbone built to showcase the dominant orange, pineapple, and resinous pine aroma. The bitterness is mild but present, and lingers a moment before disappearing, inviting another sip.

**Whitey Bulger Knew Where the Bodies Were Buried**

**New England IPA, ABV 6.5% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50**

Continuing the Famous New Englander series of NEIPA's, this edition packs a punch. A malt bill of pilsner, flaked oats, and white wheat provides a muscular backbone along with a soft and pillowy mouthfeel. An explosion of tropical fruit, citrus, and stone fruit from the dry hopping of Strata and NZ Revolution hops delivers the news. Southie for life.

**BJ Novak Didn't Start The Fire – New England IPA, ABV 6.4% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50**

Another hot take from our Famous New Englanders Series of juicy NEIPA's this beer delivers juice in force. A malt bill of Pilsner, flaked oats, and white wheat provides the support for an explosion of melon, mango and tropical citrus from the dry hopping of Mosaic, Strata and Pacific Sunrise. A soft mouthfeel along with subtle berry and earthy pine needles on the back. This one might have you singing "Ryan started the fire!" before you know it.

**On My Mind – Hazy Double IPA, ABV 8% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50**

Made specifically to celebrate Georgia Beer Day on Saturday March 9<sup>th</sup>, this beer is loaded with 5 different hops, including Idaho 7, Citra, Simcoe, Azacca, and Hop Revolution. A wonderfully juicy aroma is backed up with a ton of citrus and stone fruit that really hides the 8%.

**Amber/Red**

**Everyday Magenta – American Amber, ABV 6.1% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50 | 6 pack cans \$10.99**

Our Everyday Magenta is a modern example of the classic American Amber popularized by Fat Tire, Anchor Steam, and others. Whereas today these might be considered a bit cumbersome in their malty sweet finishes, our Everyday Magenta is lightly dry hopped with Azacca, Cascade, and Centennial hops. This results in an easy going clean bitterness, balancing the rich malt bill we utilize. Pouring a beautiful deep red hue, this is an easy drinking well balanced beer in the tradition of a Sierra Nevada Pale Ale.

**KilKevin (Nitro) – Irish Red, ABV 6.8% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50**

Irish beer fans may notice the pun in the name for this beer is a clone of the deliciously smooth Irish cream ale from Guinness called Kilkenny. Super creamy with a wonderfully thick head of foam, this beer will satisfy your Irish cravings.

## Wheat

### **Heritage Series Hefeweizen – Hefeweizen, ABV 6.0% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50**

Refreshing unfiltered wheat ale brewed with the famous Weihenstephan yeast resulting in the classic banana and clove profile famous to the style. We brew ours utilizing a traditional decoction mash to enhance the biscuity malt backbone for that full flavored Hefeweizen experience.

### **Wit Attitude – Belgian Wit, ABV 7.2% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50**

One of our favorite styles here, Witbier was almost lost to time due to the explosion of the lager style. We can thank Pierre Celis of Hoegaarden for bringing it back to life in the early 1990's. An extremely refreshing and imminently drinkable beer, there is a very light grainy sweetness with a coriander and orange peel finish. Beautiful to look at in the glass, better to drink.

## Porter/Stout

### **Everyday Black – Robust Porter, ABV 5.8% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50 | 6 pack cans \$10.99**

Everyday Black is a classic porter utilizing dark roasted malts to achieve rich flavors without relying on adjuncts. Pours a beautiful rich ebony with a luxurious creamy white head. Notes of bittersweet chocolate and espresso arrive with the first sip and the classic Fuggles hops bestow a contrasting earthy balance, while the flaked oats in the malt bill provide a silky smooth mouthfeel.

### **Nitro Stout – Nitro Stout, ABV 6.5% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50**

A deliciously smooth stout on nitro, reminiscent of beloved Guinness.

## Farmhouse

### **Vernon – Belgian Pale, ABV 8% | 14 oz draft \$8 | 7 oz draft \$4**

This beer started in our coolship where it was exposed to the cool evening air to collect our local wild yeast, and then transferred to wine barrels where it aged for 6 months before being gently lagered for 4 months. Pouring a deep autumnal orange with a rich creamy head, the aroma is sherry and muscat grape. Notes of orange and caramel arrive with the first sip, with a velvety mouthfeel. Low, clean bitterness on the backend with a smooth finish that asks for another sip.

### **Oscar – Belgian Pale, ABV 8% | 14 oz draft \$8 | 7 oz draft \$4**

Brother to Vernon, Oscar was born the same but raised differently. After the initial barrel aging Oscar then went to age on 42 lbs of tart cherries, bringing a deep and complex maturity. The color is dark mahogany in the glass. A warm, rich scent of raisin bread, stone fruit, and cardamom greets the nose. The first sip delivers a warming sensation, boozy and lush. There's cherry here, hidden in the waves, before the hops cut through with a clean soft bitterness leaving behind a subtle floral whisper.

### **Heritage Saison – Belgian Farmhouse Ale, ABV 6.5% | 14 oz draft \$8 | 7 oz draft \$4 | 500ml bottle \$8.99**

Though Saison is a French word, the Saison style of ale developed in Belgium, in the French speaking Wallonia area. It was produced in winter, to be enjoyed by seasonal farmhands through the summer until harvest and as such is a very rustic beer. Our version keeps with tradition using German Pilsner malt, malted spelt and unmalted wheat as the primary malt backbone. The subtle yet spicy aroma from Merkur and Hallertau hops blends beautifully with fruity esters from our proprietary yeast strain to create a true to style, well balanced and enjoyable beer, finishing dry with a slight earthy funk.

**Grisette – Belgian Farmhouse Ale, ABV 3.5% | 14 oz draft \$6 | 7 oz draft \$3**

Sometimes referred to as Saison's little sister, Grisette is a low ABV, light bodied, beer originally brewed for miners in the Belgian countryside. Meant to be thirst quenching and refreshing, this is a beer to be consumed in quantity after a hard day's work. Slightly spicy and earthy with a bit of a fruity ester, our version is clean and crisp and easy to drink.

**Heritage Farmhouse Ale – Farmhouse Ale, ABV 5.5% | 750ml bottle \$10.99**

This simple farmhouse style ale features a malt build of German Pilsner, Maris Otter, Rye, and Wheat. Barrel conditioned in white wine barrels for 6 months. Brilliant clarity, deep goldenrod in color with gentle tiny bubbles. Aroma is light melon rind, fresh cut grass, spicy pepper. The initial taste is very light, dancing on the palate with bright bubbles and peppery spice from the rye malt. Very dry finish

**All This Earth – Single Strain Brett, ABV 6.5% | 14 oz draft \$8 | 7 oz draft \$4**

A delicate dance of Brettanomyces and fruit, we wanted to impart a subtle savory note to this funky ale. Utilizing a small amount of black malt alongside the brett and blackberries, this ale is akin to momma's blackberry crumble. Exceptionally dry with subtle tartness that dissolves quickly.

## Sours

**Gutenberg's Gose – Gose, ABV 4.2% | 16 oz draft \$6 | 8 oz draft \$3**

Gose – pronounced 'go-suh' – is a warm fermented beer that originated in Goslar Germany. A beer style that almost went extinct, it was brought back in vogue in the early 2000's by enterprising breweries experimenting with historic styles. Slightly salty owing to the minerals in the water in Goslar, our Gose pays homage to the original but we add hibiscus flower and lime for a bit of color and zest.

**PMS 162 – Peach Lemonade Sour, ABV 5.2% | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50 | 4 pack cans \$13.99**

For those in the printing world, PMS stands for Pantone Matching System. This particular color is Pantone's color of the year for 2024. The Pantone Matching System (PMS) is used to communicate color expectations and to maintain consistent results across many different platforms, from a monitor to a printing press. We're using it to let you know the beer you're about to enjoy is pink and tastes like a peach lemonade. Enjoy!

## High Gravity

**Blanket Smasher – Barleywine, ABV 14.0% - | 10 oz draft \$8**

Barleywines aren't wine at all, but typically on the higher end of the ABV scale. We pack a large amount of malt in the mash to get this level of alcohol and an extra helping of hops to help balance the beer. The results are a very complex and rich beer. Our version is an English style barleywine, where we let more of the malt characteristics come through. The result is a toasty, toffee like initial sip followed up by layers of currant and warm bread.

**Artifact 2023 – Barrel Aged Imperial Stout, ABV 14% | 10 oz draft \$8 | 500ml bottle \$16.99**

Artifact has always been a big beer, but this year's version ups the ante. Made with the finest malts, we boiled the wort for six hours to further distill and concentrate the beer before primary fermentation. Left to mature in ASW barrels, Artifact returns for 2023 as a rich and decadent imperial stout. Everything about it is big – the aroma overwhelms the nose with luscious bittersweet chocolate, boozy barrel, and hazelnut. The first sip is velvety and luxurious, bittersweet dark chocolate again, a bit of vanilla and sandalwood. A warm, soothing finish invites another sip. Find your Artifact.

## Spontaneous Fermentation

### **Woodcut Wild Ales – Méthode Traditionnelle, ABV 6.5%**

Our Woodcut Wild Ales are our interpretation of traditional Belgian lambic beer. We use pilsner malt and unmalted wheat in a turbid mash to create a proper bed for the yeasts and bacteria to thrive over time. Hops from our own hopyard, aged 2 years, are added for flavor and as a preservative. These beers will spend 2 to 3 years in barrel in our wild room, aging and developing the unique and characteristic acidity and dryness indicative of the style. Whereas modern lambics can be sweet and cloying, the original style we strive for is very crisp and effervescent.

- **Mixed Berry | 14 oz draft \$8 | 7 oz \$4** - Aged on 100 lbs of mixed black and raspberries, and as such is very fruit forward. It pours a hazy rose with a vibrant berry nose. Bright and crisp, the berries arrive and dance on the palate for a moment before dissipating cleanly, with a lingering acidity and no residual sweetness.
- **Kriek | 14 oz draft \$8 | 7 oz \$4 | 375ml bottle \$10.99** - Aged on sweet cherries. Pouring a brilliant ruby red with a bubbly pink head. The aroma is cherry with the brett lending a slight earthy mustiness underneath. A light, bubbly body tickles the palate with tart cherry upfront and a dry earthy finish.
- **Framboise | 375ml bottle \$10.99** – Bottle Service, quiet pour recommended - Pouring a beautiful hazy rose with a persistent head, the aroma is a powerful berry jam. Very tart and bright, the mouthfeel is effervescent. Raspberry/strawberry dominates the initial taste, receding gently, allowing the breadiness of the malt to come forward. Very dry, nothing lingers except for the berry.
- **Peche | 375ml bottle \$10.99** – Bottle Service, quiet pour recommended - Aged on peaches. Pouring a brilliant straw yellow, the aroma is earthy barnyard, hay. Light and playful, the peaches impart a very delicate, unassuming impression. Finishing with a bit of lemongrass and slight tartness.
- **Grand Cru | 375ml bottle \$12.99** – Bottle Service, quiet pour recommended
- **Plum | 14 oz draft \$8 | 7 oz \$4** – bright peach in color, this ale pours with a creamy persistent head. The aroma is plum and watermelon. At first sip, the dryness is immediate along with a tingle and a sparkly light body. Deliciously simple, light plum and a super clean finish make for a wonderfully tasty ale.

## Seltzers/Cider/Hop Water

### **Seltzers – ABV 5.0% | 16 oz draft \$6 | 8 oz draft \$3**

What can we say: just a simple low carb, gluten free seltzer with clean and crisp fruit flavors:

### **Cider – Cider, ABV 5.0% - | 16 oz draft \$7 | 8 oz draft \$3.50**

Bright gold with a warm apple nose, our cider drinks dry and sparkling, not sweet. Clean, crisp, refreshing.

### **Hop Water – Water infused with hops, Non-Alcoholic | 16 oz draft \$2**

We know this sounds odd, but it's not bitter at all. This is more like an herbal tea, with the natural antioxidant qualities and health benefits of hops.
